Services Provided: Supervises adults who have been convicted of a crime while practicing the principles of restorative justice (i.e., community protections, accountability and competency development), make referrals to treatment providers for individual, group and family counseling. Also procure in-patient services for those probationers who suffer from long standing problems related to substance abuse. As is the case in the juvenile system, education and a developing a greater sense of responsibility is emphasized with our probationers. Adult probationers, especially those that are in the house arrest program, do a significant amount of community service work throughout the county (e.g., cleaning city/county parks, etc.) The A.P.S.D. also supervises cases for the limited jurisdiction Courts and operates the Adult Diversion program.
