This behavior workshop (TBI 202) will include an overview of brain-behavior relationships, the importance of executive functions, and signs/symptoms of brain injury and neurological impairments as observable behaviors. Focus will be on determining students' strengths and assets using a hypothesis testing approach (OCCHTA) to conduct behavioral assessments and create appropriate interventions/strategies for the classroom and community. The format will be lecture with open discussion, situation study and one case study with an emphasis on strengthening team interactions. Materials will be provided. **There is no cost for the workshop; however, you must be pre-registered and you must have taken TBI 101 prior to this workshop.**

**This workshop will run from 8:00 AM until 4:00 PM with registration at 7:45 AM.** There will be two, 15-minute breaks. A one-hour lunch is planned and will be on your own.
